Heroism in the vicinity of Chok-Ko-Ri, Korea on 8 August 1952 while serving as a rifleman in Company L. 15th Infantry Regiment, 3d Infantry Division. During a fire-fight, Private First Class Wolfe became aware that a comrade had been hit by enemy fire. Volunteering, and with utter disregard for his personal safety, he moved from his covered position across fire swept terrain until he reached the soldier only to find him dead. Determined to retrieve the body, he crawled through deadly enemy fire and dragged the body to a covered position, then single handidly floated him to a collection point downstream. Private First Class Wolfe's outstanding heroism reflects great credit on him and the United States Army.
